

Watercolor & Mixed Media with Peggy Ross

Supply List

You Bring to each class session:

Watercolor set up:

- paint – minimum of 3 primary colors (red, yellow, blue) – preferably watercolor tube paints.
- palette – includes a place for primary paints and good sized color mixing spaces.
- 2 water containers for rinsing brushes (cups, jars, yogurt containers, or?)
- watercolor brushes – minimum of 2 rounds brushes with good tips, 1 larger (#14 - #16) and one smaller (#4 - #8). Any other watercolor brushes you like to use.
- board & tape (to tape your paper on while painting)

Paper: A tablet or quantity of 140 lb. or heavier, cold pressed, 9”X12” papers. Brands I like are Canson, Arches or Fabriano, but use your favorite.

Cotton rag or paper towels.

#2 pencil & eraser

An object from your house, smaller than 12”X12”X18”, larger than 4”X4”X4” (approximately).

Bring if you have on hand (no need to purchase if you don't):

Sharpies or other ink pens

Colored pencils

Pastels

Graphite drawing pencils

Teacher will provide:

A variety of drawing media for your use in class, including:

- oil pastels
- water soluble crayons/pencils
- ink pens
- & more

Drawing / Sketch paper

Water pitchers & dump buckets

Misc. supplies (as needed)
