Required

-Watercolor paper pad: 9”X12”, white or off white, Cold Press, 140 lb. minimum paper weight,
Good brands include: Canson, 1264 Fabriano, Arches,

-2 Round Brushes: with good, pointed tips.

-One smaller size (#4 - #6) and

-One larger size (#14-#16)

A medium quality line is Princeton SNAP! series.

-Palette: a covered palette with slanted wells and larger mixing areas. White plastic, resin, enamel, porcelain or metal. Around 8”X10” or 10”X12”. (approximate size).

-Roll of blue, painters masking tape

-Board around 12” X14”, Masonite or similar hard surface.

Used for taping watercolor paper to before wetting/painting.

-Pencil

-Soft eraser

Optional

-1/2”-3/4” watercolor wash brush

-cotton rag

-Artists Color wheel Watercolor Color Wheel
